Understanding the different factors that ensured Britain's victory in WW2.</p> <p><b>MORE CHALLENGING:</b><br/>To regularly attempt extension questions in lessons, specifically designed to practice exam style questions. Pupils will begin categorising greater and lesser factors for WW2 victory.</p> <p><b>MOST CHALLENGING:</b><br/>Pupils will understand the long term impact of both Depression and War and the political ramifications this will have.
