<p><u>Tips</u> - Analyse and pick out 2 key details from both sources A and B</p>	<p><u>Tips</u> - Paragraph 1 should briefly discuss the source content. Paragraph 2 should analyse and evaluate the accuracy of the source using your knowledge.</p>	<p><u>Tips</u> - Paragraph 1 should discuss the topic/situation beforehand. Paragraph 2 should discuss the topic/situation itself. Paragraph 3 should discuss the impact and significance that the topic/situation had during the time/longer term.</p>	<p><u>Tips</u> - Paragraph 1 should focus on the first chosen topic. Links should be made between the other topics. Paragraph 2 should focus on the second chosen topic. Again, make links where possible. Paragraph 3 should focus on the third chosen topic. Make links where possible.</p>	<p><u>Tips</u> - FACTORS! Paragraph 1 - Analyse the interpretation. What does it say? Who said it? Does this make it more/less reliable? Paragraph 2 - Other factor. What else lead to the factor in the question? Paragraph 3 - Third factor. Paragraph 4 - Conclusion - Overall how far do you agree with the interpretation?</p>
