



Year 8 Homework Natural Art IMPROVING YOUR LEARNING

Task 1:

Create a front cover for your project. Your front cover should have an impact as it is the first thing your teacher will see! Your front page should be inspired by Nature, so make it decorative, colourful and eye catching.

Use A4 paper

Include the following:

Your Name & Your Class

Title 'Natural Art'



Task 2:

Collect your favorite examples of Art by Andy Goldsworthy.

Create an A4 collage with the images you have collected.

Explain how you think they were created and what you like about them.

Cut up the images neatly and arrange them carefully with the text.

Extension task: Draw a natural form. Choose a flower, bud, leaf, tree, seed pod or anything natural and create a detailed drawing. Use the drawing method I have taught you to structure your drawing.



Task 3:

What makes Andy Goldsworthy's Art interesting? Is it Art? How does it differ from and relate to your work?

In your own words answer fully the above questions. **Think** carefully about the skills you have learned and the abilities you have developed and how they could help you to create Artworks such as the Saliva Star

Research and present a balanced view on A4 paper. Add in images and quotes to reinforce your point of view.



Task 4:

Using Found natural objects create a piece of Art inspired by Andy Goldsworthy's Artworks. Collect leaves, twigs, berries, flowers, nuts, fruit and veg; you could even use snow or ice.

Using your gathered pieces as inspiration, sketch out a design for your Goldsworthy inspired Artwork. Annotate your drawing by explaining what you are designing and how you are going to make it.



Extension Task: Create a step by step guide of 'How to create a Andy Goldsworthy inspired Artwork'.

Task 5:

1. In a suitable, safe outdoor area, create your design using the found natural objects you have collected.
2. Use your design or your step-by-step guide as an instruction manual To follow as you construct your piece of Art.
3. Remember! Many of Andy Goldsworthy's Artworks are not permanent pieces, they disappear with time, the wind or weather conditions. Do not use anything other than natural materials to create your final piece. (No glue, nails, string or tape).
4. Remember the main themes in Andy Goldsworthy's Artworks are The Snake, The Egg and The Circle.
5. Use a camera to record your final piece as this will be the only record of the work.



REMEMBER!



If you are unsure what to do just ask your teacher, they will be happy to help you.

All homework must be presented neatly on A4 paper. Your project must have a front cover and be fastened together.
