Task 1:

Create a front cover for your project. Your front cover should have an impact as it is the first thing your teacher will see. Your front page should be inspired by Graffiti Art, so make it colourful and eye catching.

Include the following:

- Your Name & Your Class
- Title 'Graffiti Art'



Task 2:



Collect your favorite examples of Graffiti Art by Banksy. Create an A4 collage with the images you have collected.



Cut up the images neatly and arrange them carefully.

Extension task: Draw one of the Banksy images from your collage. Add colour using paint, oil pastel or pencil crayon.

Task 3:

IS GRAFFITI ART??

Present a balanced argument for and against Graffiti as an Art form in its own right.

Research this subject and present a balanced argument for both sides on A4 paper. Use images and quotes to reinforce both arguments.

Type the following into google to find articles by to help you with the task.

You could present this in the form of a newspaper article.

Task 4:

Use the current **Llandrindod High School** logo, **develop it into a new Graffiti inspired design.**

Your design should be bold, eye catching and colourful. Look at examples of graffiti artists work for inspiration.

You may want to use an ICT design package, paint, oil pastels, pencil crayons or collage to add colour to your design.

Create your design on A4 paper.



Task 5:

Banksy's work frequently comments on issues in society.

Choose one of the issues listed below or choose your own as inspiration for your work.

- Bullying
- Racism
- Drugs



Create a Graffiti inspired piece of art which highlights the issues you have researched. Your design must be presented on A4 paper.



Extension Task:

Aim to use stenciling in your work.



Write a paragraph explaining the meaning behind your work, what it represents and how it links to the work of Banksy.
