DCF TASK IDEA



Encourage pupils to create simple flowcharts to help them remember processes.

Flowcharts are a simple visual representation of a pupil's thinking process. Pupils could create a simple flowchart in the back of their book to reference when needed throughout the task. Flowcharts can be a useful planning tool, such as the text planning skeletons.

Developing this computational thinking skill enables pupils to:

- Think about how to approach a task
- Identify a missing element of a task
- Review work more effectively

TOP TIP

Did you know you can undo nearly any action in a Windows operating system? You probably know that pressing Ctrl + Z will undo anything you just typed, but this also applies to everything else.

For example, if you accidentally moved or deleted a file, hitting Ctrl + Z will bring it right back to its original location.
