## DCF TASK IDEA



Pupils obviously need to evaluate their digital work based on your subject criteria, but they should also evaluate elements from the digital criteria. Below are questions that pupils could answer to enhance their understanding of the purpose of a digital task.

- How did you create your work to suit the audience?
- What was the purpose of this digital piece of work?
- Why did you choose that colour scheme?
- Did you reference images/texts that were not yours?
- What tools or features did you add to your presentation?
- How did these tools enhance your work?
- Could you have created a different output? E.g. made an animation instead of a PowerPoint
- What digital improvements could you make if you were creating this again?

## TOP TIP
