If you are setting a homework task, why not implement part of the Interacting and Collaborating strand?

Set pupils a task where they can use Office 365 on Hwb to work on a document collaboratively in real-time. This will teach them how to:

- Share documents online
- Use appropriate sharing permissions
- Work on the same document from separate locations

This is a skill that will be greatly useful to them in later education and the world of work.

TOP TIP



If you are looking for a way of sharing web links with pupils in a classroom without the need for them to copy hyperlinks or use MS Teams, why not try using QR codes.

QR codes are quick and easy to create and can be linked to any online resource.

The uses for QR codes are endless and all that is required is for pupils to scan the QR code with their smartphone camera and they will be taken to the link.
