



- <u>Belief</u> to accept that something exists or is true, especially without proof.
- Faith to show complete trust or confidence in someone of something.

Discussion What is the

between belief,
fact and opinion?

 <u>Belief</u> – to accept that something exists or is true, especially without proof. It is based on cultural or personal faith or values.

 <u>Fact</u> – this is something that is backed up with evidence. It relies on observation or research.

• <u>opinion</u> – this is subjective and can be based on feelings or personal experience. It is an expression of a judgement or belief about something. It's an assumption.


